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Palmyra's Early Graduation Policy allows a student to earn a maximum of two (2) additional credits towards high school graduation via an approved online program or other educational institution at his/her own cost. No more than one (1) credit in any discipline will be approved. In order to be eligible for interscholastic athletics, a student must be enrolled in a full-time curriculum and be passing four full-credit subjects. Students who graduate in January will still be permitted to attend the prom and participate in other non-athletic extra-curricular activities unless the Principal deems otherwise on a case-by-case basis. The online high school curriculum allows students to choose necessary courses in order to meet PASD graduation requirements. Please see Board Policy 217 for more information.

The courses are designed to allow for a student to work at his or her own pace; however, the student's teacher and learning coach will monitor progress and offer assistance as needed to complete the coursework in a timely manner. All grades will be kept online so that parents and students can check grades on a routine basis.

The price per course is \$400 for a one-credit course and \$200 for a half-credit. The cost must be paid in full at time of registration and is non-refundable.

Students are required to attend a mandatory one- hour orientation session on June 16th from 9am -10am. Courses will run from June 16-July 25 for one-credit courses and June 16 through July 7 for half-credit courses.

Students must have Internet and computer access at home.
