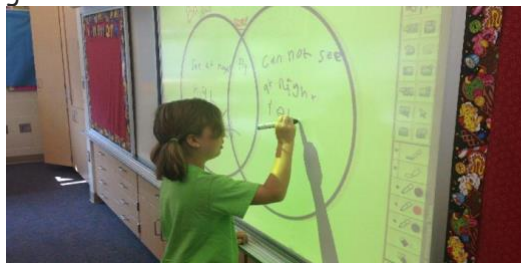

**What is the CUB program?**

CUB is a four-week summer camp focused on literacy. Students in the program receive small group reading instruction daily. They also receive large group instruction in math, review of content through technology integration, and a recreational activity that focuses on fine-tuning social skills. In addition to these daily small group activities, the students receive free breakfast and lunch.



### What happens in a day at CUB?

Students will be given a breakfast bar, if needed. They rotate through four stations and then eat lunch. **Arrival is 8:55**, sessions are 9:00-11:15, and **lunch is served at 11:00**. **Dismissal is at 11:15**. All sessions take place at Pine St. Elementary School.

### Who can participate?

The program is designed for students who can benefit from instruction in the summer months to maintain or increase skills.



### When does this take place?

Monday, Tuesday, Wednesday, and Thursday for the weeks of:  
July 9, 16, 23 and 30  
9:00-11:15 a.m.

### Daily attendance is crucial to success in the program.

### What is the program fee?

\$300 per child  
\$250 per sibling  
breakfast bar and lunch are included

The program is offered free to students of economically disadvantaged status as defined by the lunch program.



### Supporting Data

Over the last four years of the Pat's CUBs program, 62.4% of students improved or maintained their reading level (DRA May-Sept.). In math, 60% of students maintained or showed growth in math. This is outstanding when we consider that the target group for the program would normally suffer from "summer slide" (a decrease in skill level over the summer). With the help of Pat's CUBs, more of our students entered school in August ready for the school year!
