Focus Group Report

May 7, 2014

RLPS Architects conducted 6 focus groups with a variety of students, facilities and athletic staff, Administration, faculty, school board and the public to identify expectations, potential changes and the services required to meet these expectations. Utilizing Crawford Slips participants anonymously submitted their responses to questions before a general group discussion. This resulted in 1,210 individual responses. The objective was to identify concerns and stimulate ideas in an open and proactive setting. The following is a synopsis of the focus group results and outcome.

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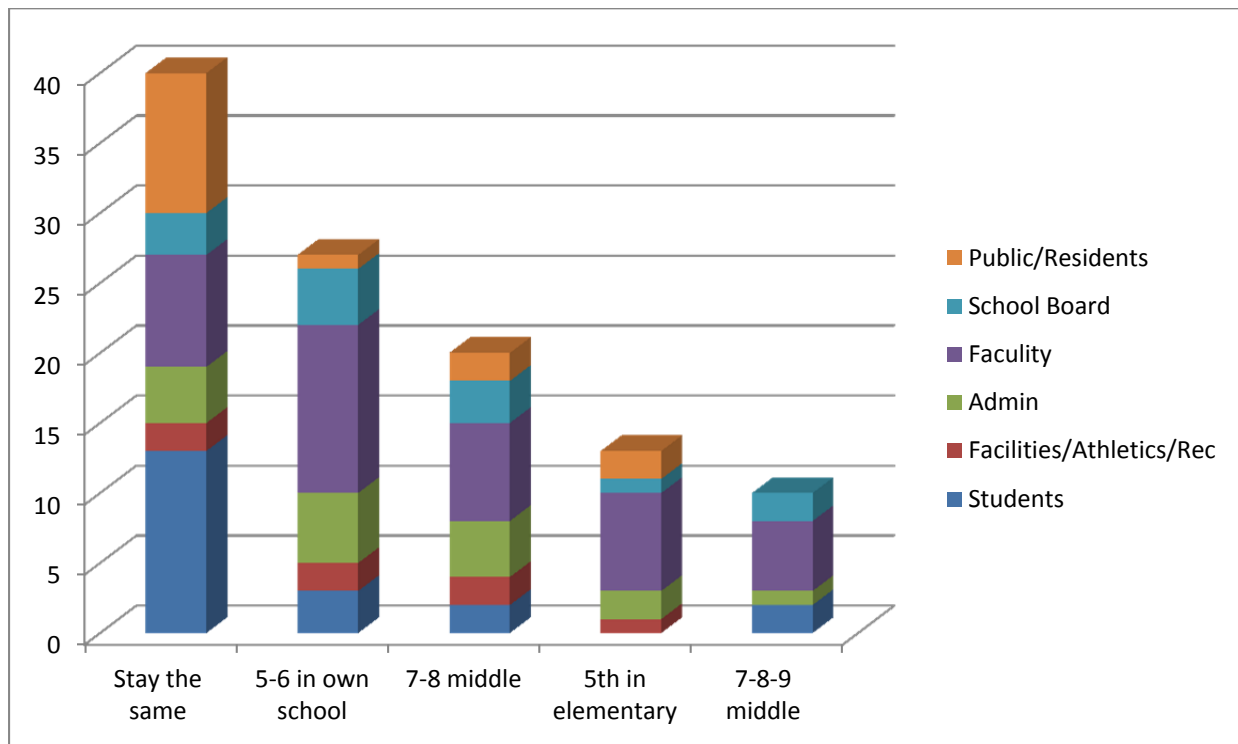

- 7-8-9 middle – 10

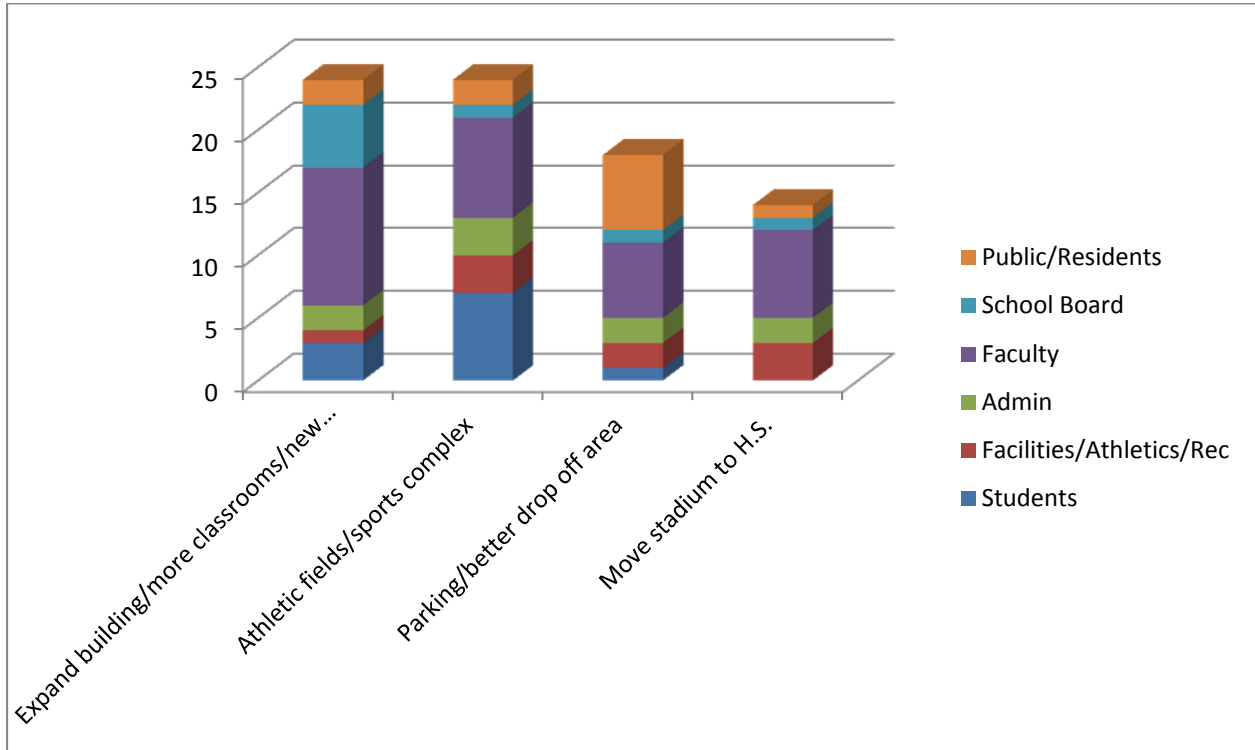

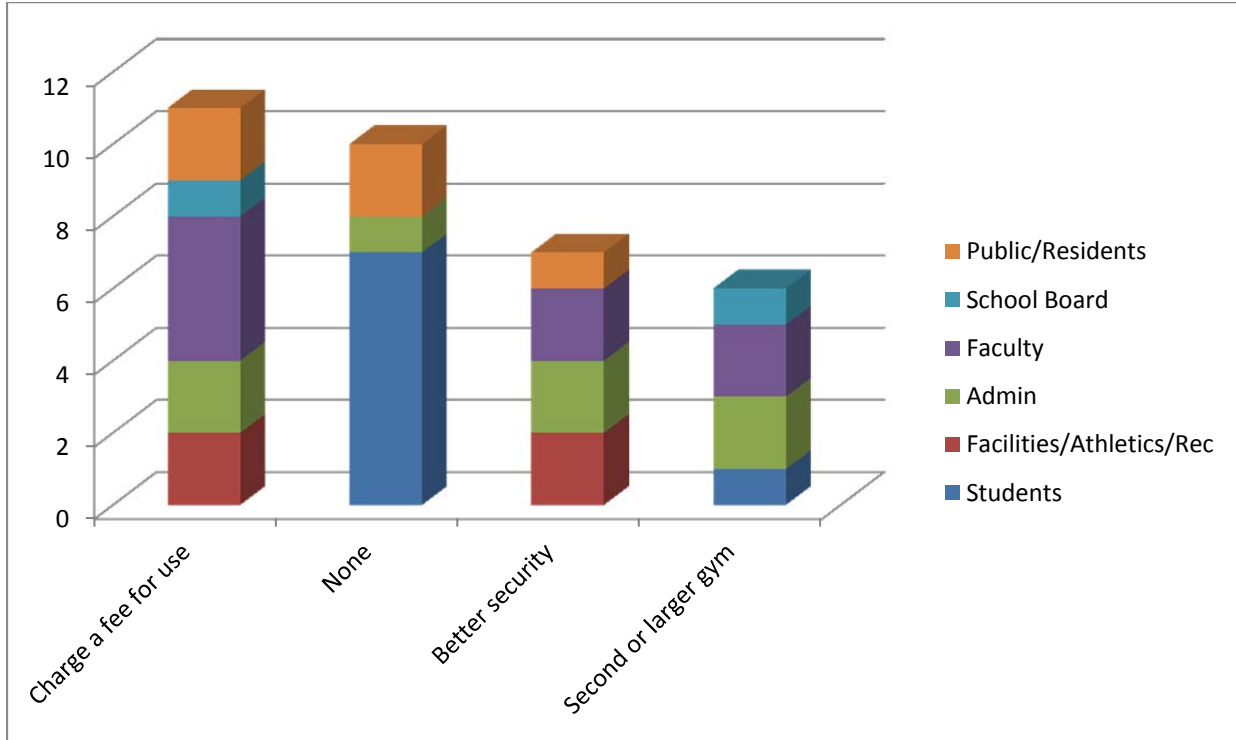

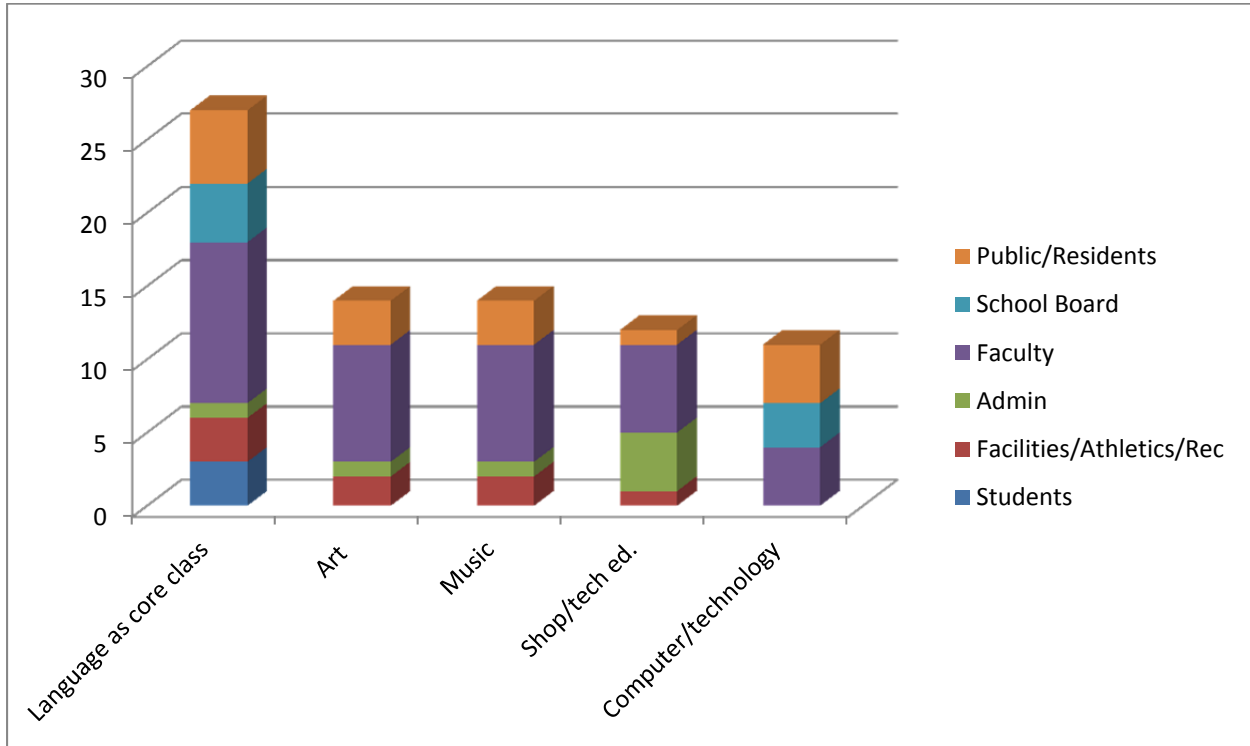

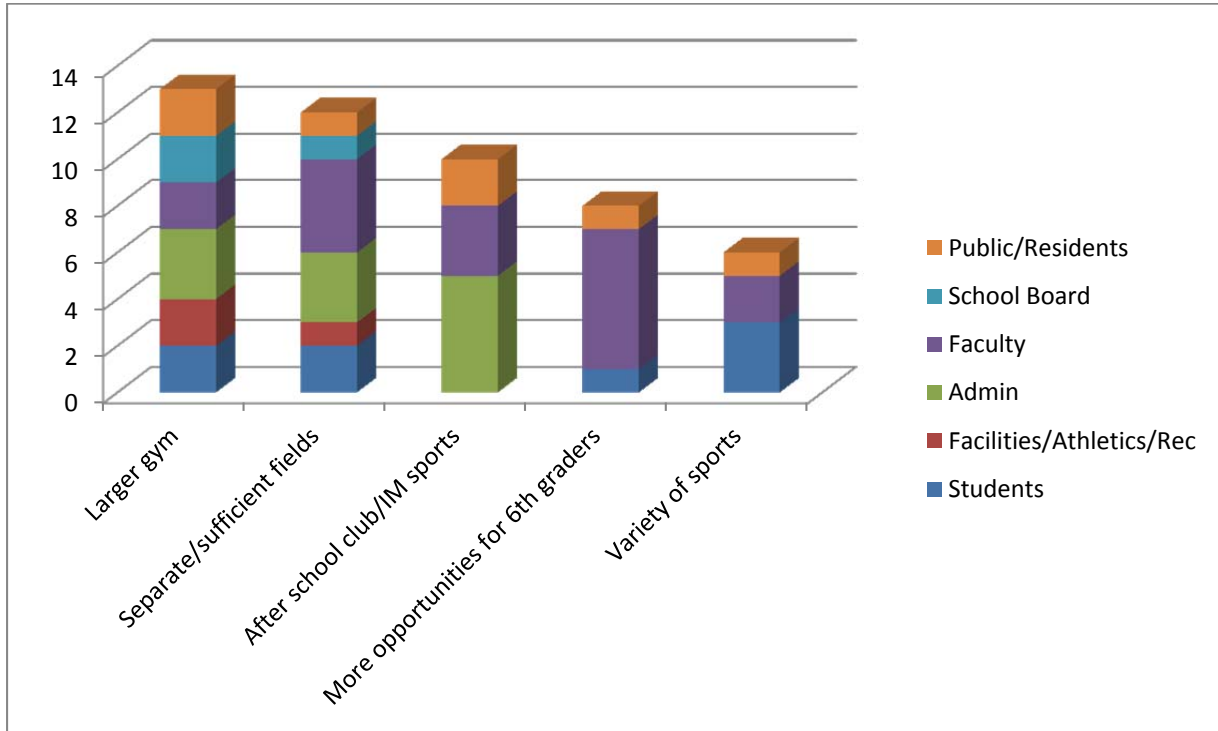

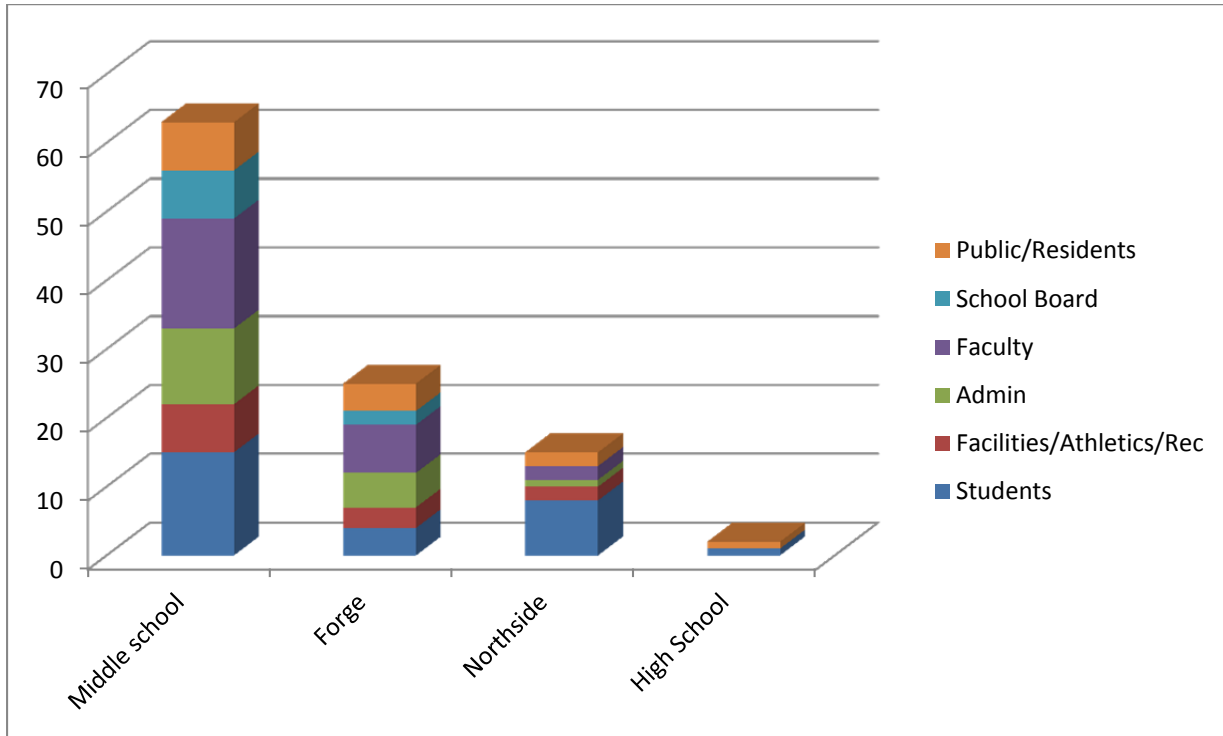

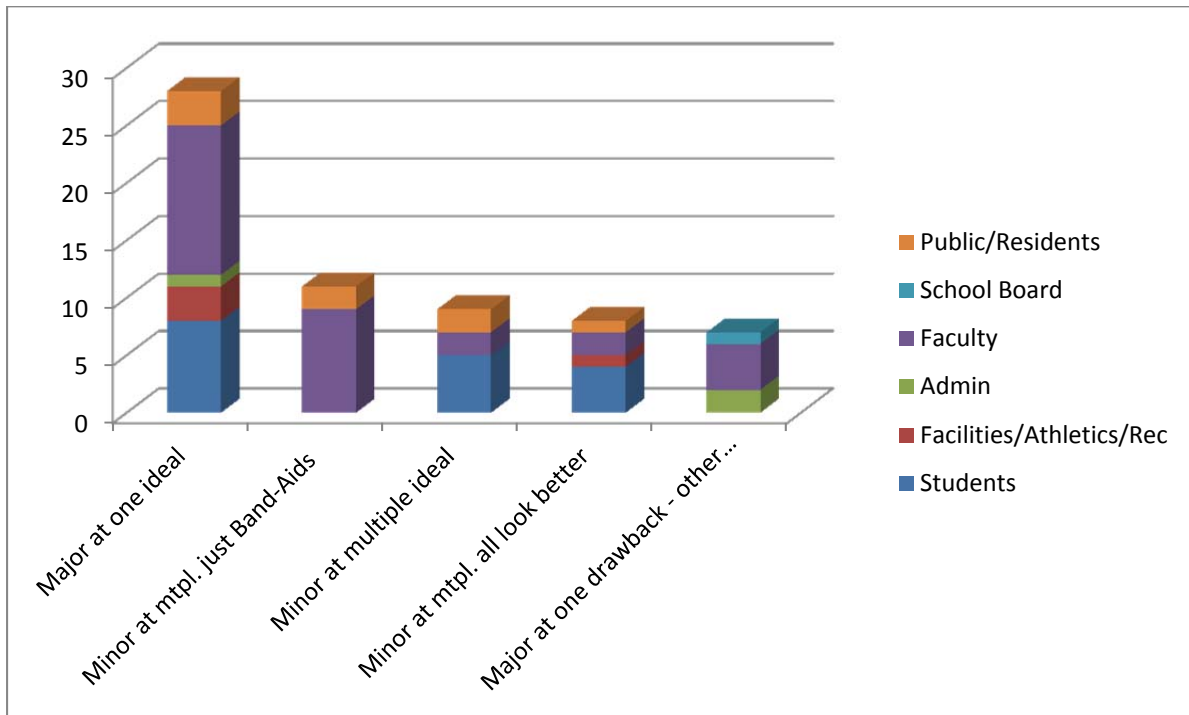

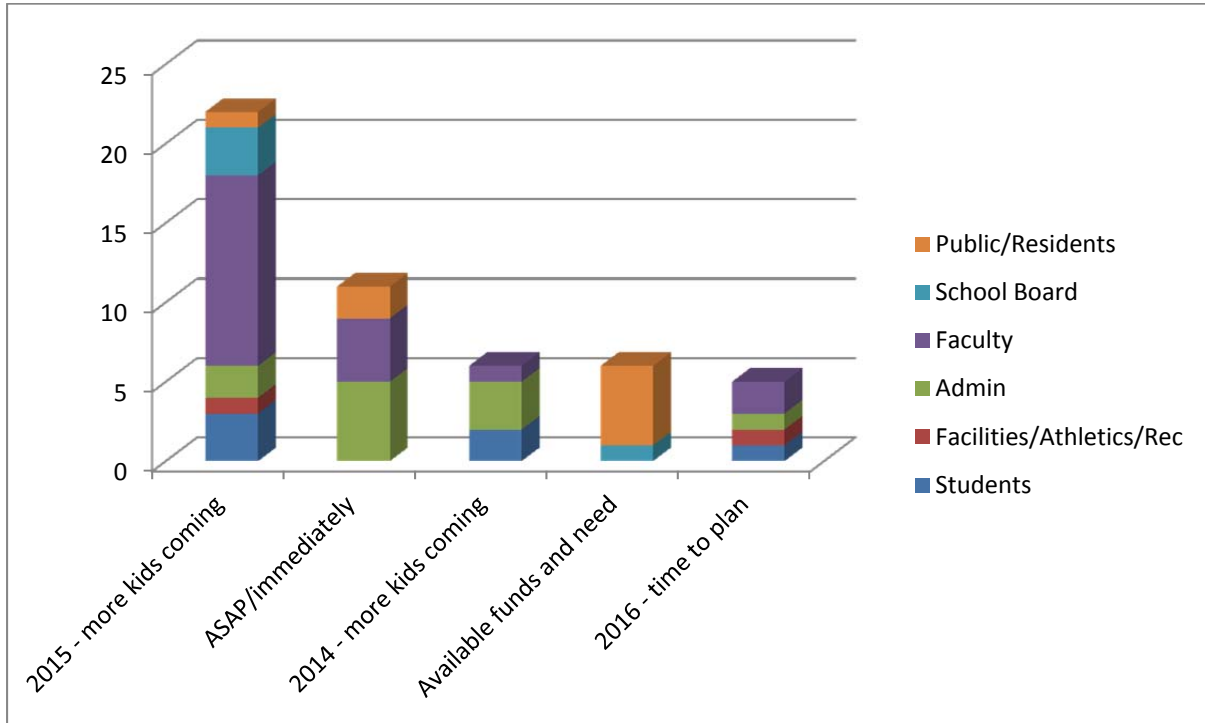

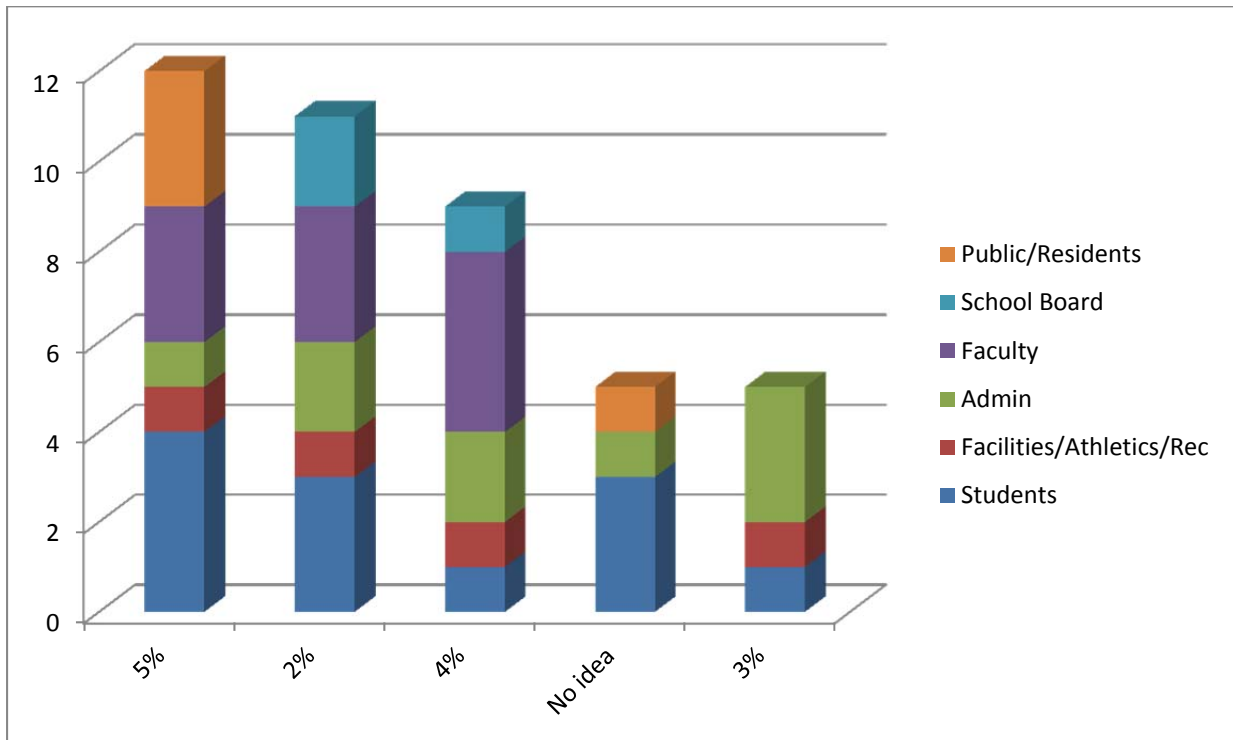
