

SUMMER 2019 RENOVATIONS UPDATE

The 2018-19 school year has been another busy year for renovations projects. We celebrated the completion of major projects at the Middle School and Forge Road Elementary. See the Building Dedication booklet for highlights. At the same time, we were planning the following projects to be completed this summer:

1. Forge Road Traffic Pattern Redesign – See link to a rendering. This was estimated at a total cost of \$1.2 million. On May 9, the bid was awarded to Ebersole Excavating in the amount of \$670,200, under budget by \$200,000 for the portion of the project excluding soft costs.
2. LED lights will be installed in the four remaining buildings (Northside, Pine, Lingle and High School) under a Guaranteed Energy Savings Agreement with Reynolds Energy Services at a cost of \$747,728 and annual savings of \$44,650.
3. Northside Phase I involves construction of a new stairwell and the renovation of “Chill and Sensory” rooms for the Emotional support classroom at a cost of \$541,063, also part of the Guaranteed Energy Savings Agreement with Reynolds. Phase II design is continuing and will be bid in the fall to address other needs identified in the Facility Study – See link.
4. Other projects scheduled for this summer include the following:
 - New surveillance camera system at the High School at a cost of \$100,570, partially funded by a \$25,000 safe schools grant.
 - Gym floor refinishing at Pine, Lingle, Middle School and High School
 - Parking lot repairs and lining at Middle School and High School
 - Installation of a playground fence at Lingle and safety net system at High School softball field
 - Press box and scoreboard upgrades at Buck Swank Stadium
