On a separate sheet, please include a list of any volunteer experience and community service that you have been involved with.

Criteria: Your essay will be read by a panel of our senior residents. Each essay will be evaluated using the following measures.

Format/Style: 10%

Grammar: 20%

Essay Content: 50%

Volunteer Experience: 20%
