

MARCH 1 DEADLINE

BIG 33 ACADEMIC SCHOLARSHIP FUND: for students in PA planning to attend a technical school or accredited college or university following high school graduation. (Multiple winners/ up to \$2,000 each)

PENNSYLVANIA HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES SCHOLARSHIP: for graduating seniors and legal residents of PA, with a minimum 3.0 GPA, planning to attend any four year college in PA, and demonstrating leadership and community service (Two recipients/Amount varies)

LOU DRANE FUND / JOSEPH L. AND VIVIAN E. STEELE FUND: for students from Adams, Cumberland, Dauphin, Franklin, Fulton, Juniata, Lancaster, Lebanon, Montour, Northumberland, Perry, Snyder, and York Counties, studying classical music composition, teaching, and performance (Multiple recipients/Up to \$5,000)

MARCH 15 DEADLINE

GARY D. RADINE SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM: for dependent children of a Delta Dental employee attending a two- or four-year accredited college as a full-time student with a minimum GPA of 3.0 and participating in extracurricular activities, work experience, and community service (Two recipients/\$5,000)

MARCH 30 DEADLINE

FAMILY & CHILDREN'S SERVICES OF LEBANON COUNTY FUND: Students who are residents of Lebanon County, pursuing higher education degrees in social sciences and human services, including fields such as medicine, nursing, social work, mental health, and other specialized therapies in the treatment of physical and mental disabilities (Multiple recipients/Amount varies)

APRIL 1

EASH-POTTER SCHOLARSHIP FUND: the scholarship will support students committed to improving the campus and community climate for LGBTQ people (Number of recipients varies/Amount varies)

ELY-WAIN SCHOLARSHIP FUND: for graduating seniors from a high school in Cumberland, Dauphin, Franklin, Lebanon, or Perry Counties with plans to pursue a field of study leading to a "green career" including to Environmental Science and Sustainable Technology (Number of recipients varies/Amount varies)

THAD G. GAYMAN MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP FUND: for graduating seniors planning to attend a two-year or four-year college, university, or trade school as a full-time automotive technician student. Minimum GPA of 2.5 (One recipient/Amount varies)

GROVE FAMILY FUND #2 — HACC: for students attending Harrisburg Area Community College as a full-time or part time student. Minimum GPA of 2.0 or higher (Two recipients/Amount varies)

LEON I. LOCK AND BARBARA R. LOCK SCHOLARSHIP FUND: for graduating seniors and graduates within the last five years of any high school in Cumberland, Dauphin, Franklin, Lebanon, or Perry Counties, who will attend HACC to study nursing (Multiple recipients/Up to \$500)

BRUCE MANGIONE FUND: for students who attend school within the city of Harrisburg and children of the employees of NRG Energy (Harrisburg office) or Harrisburg Hilton and Towers (Two recipients/Up to \$1,500)

PENNHOSA FOUNDATION SCHOLARSHIP FUND: for affiliated, paid HOSA chapter members by January 1 with financial need (Multiple recipients/Amount varies)

PARTS SCHOLARSHIP PENNSYLVANIA AUTOMOTIVE RECYCLING TRADE SOCIETY: for a child or step child of an owner who is an eligible active PARTS member or an employee who has worked for an eligible PARTS member for at least one year prior to March 15 or a child or step child of such an employee (Multiple recipients/Amount varies)

RICE FAMILY SCHOLARSHIP FUND OF EICHELBERGERS, INC: for graduating seniors who are dependent children of employees of Eichelbergers, Inc. (employed for at least one year), with a minimum 2.5 GPA, planning to attend any two or four year college in PA (Multiple recipients/Up to \$2,000 each per year for up to four years)

DR. FRANCIS J. VIOZZI MEMORIAL EDUCATIONAL SCHOLARSHIP FOR ENVIRONMENTAL STUDIES: for graduating seniors from any Dauphin or Lebanon County high school with plans to attend a four-year institution of higher education. The student must have a concentration in science related to environmental conservation (biology, wildlife management, environmental studies, engineering, etc.) (One recipient/Up to \$1,500)

WALTERS SERVICES, INC. FABE & BEVERLY WALTERS SCHOLARSHIP FUND: Applicants must be children of employees under the age of 26, or must be a seasonal employee under the age of 26, with plans to attend college, university, or a trade school as a full-time or part-time student. (Number of recipients varies/Amount varies)

MATCHING AWARD OPPORTUNITIES

AES/PHEAA's PATH Program: Scholarship recipients are eligible to have their awards matched on a dollar-for-dollar basis by AES/PHEAA's PATH ("Partnerships for Access to Higher Education") Program. PHEAA may grant matching funds to scholarship recipients who are enrolled in an approved Pennsylvania college or career school as an undergraduate student on at least a half-time basis, who are a Pennsylvania state grant recipient and who demonstrate financial need. Students must also be a resident of Pennsylvania, not in default on any educational loans, maintain academic progress, and not be considered an incarcerated student. The match provides last-dollar support for tuition and fees. *Scholarship funds used for reimbursement of textbook purchases are not eligible for a PATH Program match.* The scholarship recipient's information is submitted to PHEAA by TFEC staff.
