

Word Wall Word Ideas!



Dear Parents,

Here are some ideas to practice word wall words at home!

- *Spread the flashcards on the floor and have your child read and jump on them.
- *Rainbow write the words: You write the word, they trace over it using different colors.
- *Make words out of playdough.
- *Play "Go fish" with flashcards.
- *Play "Oh No" game: Write word wall words on popsicle sticks or cards, put them in a bag, add some with the words "Oh, NO!" on them. Take turns picking sticks/cards- if your child can read it, they get the stick/card, if not they have to put it back. If you get the "Oh no" stick/card, you have to put all of them back in. See who gets the most sticks/cards.
- *Write words with shaving cream/finger paint them.
- *Play a memory game.
- *Spread words out and give clues. Ex: Which word has four letters and starts with s? Which word rhymes with book? Which words have 3 letters?
- *Sort words- write all words that have 2 letters in blue, write words with 3 letters yellow, etc.
- *Write www letters out of order, have your child unscramble them.
- *Who can use the most www in a sentence?
- *Play "Read my mind". Give clues such as "this word wall word has 3 letters, starts with the same sound that cat starts with, and ends with the "m" sound. Take turns reading minds!
