Curriculum

The high school curriculum (9-12) allows students to choose necessary courses in order to meet PASD graduation requirements. All courses will be completed online. Students will be enrolled in the Cougar Academy orientation course in addition to their content course.

Although the ability to access the coursework and complete assignments on-line is a vital component of this educational program, the district believes the access to a certified teacher is just as important. The courses are designed to allow for a student to work at his or her own pace; however, the student's teacher and learning coach will monitor progress and offer assistance as needed to complete the coursework in a timely manner. All grades will be kept online so parents and students can check grades and assignments.

Summer school will begin at 8:00 am on June 28 and end at 3:00 pm on August 6th. The price per course is \$400 for a one-credit course and \$200 for a half-credit. The cost must be paid in full at time of registration and is non-refundable. An application and payment must be received by 2 pm on June 22 in order for a student to be enrolled in summer school.

Students will be able to use their school issued laptops but must have Internet access at home. If you are interested or need more information, please see your school guidance counselor.
