- Without a federal waiver from state testing, the Pennsylvania State Assessments (PSSA, PASA and Keystone Exams) are required. The Commonwealth, under the federal guidance, has enabled school districts to postpone testing until summer or fall. It is our intent to continue testing during the spring testing window. As a result, Keystone Exams are scheduled for May 17, 18, and 19. To test in small groups, up to 30 proctors are needed for the nearly 250 student testers each day. Students not testing will be involved in asynchronous days on these three testing dates at the high school.
- The Commonwealth's roll-out of the Johnson and Johnson vaccine for education is nearing completion. Wave one vaccines were prioritized by the state and included special education staff, elementary staff, food service staff and bus drivers. PASD's allocation of vaccines in wave one allowed some secondary staff to be vaccinated (March 11-19). Wave two, which is taking place March 25 and 26, includes the remainder of our secondary staff. We also have staff who are awaiting a second dose of the Moderna vaccine that they were able to obtain based on qualifications under Phase IA of the Department of Health's vaccination plan.
